DRA – Penny mentioned that the Municipal Bureau Supervisor Bruce Kneuer will be presenting the tax rate setting session of the New Collectors' workshop and Derek Kline, Assistant Revenue Counsel will present the Ethics session.

Dawn mentioned she would like to use both Michelle and Penny to facilitate the New Collectors' WebEx workshop sessions. Dawn is going to set up a time to run through how the WebEx sessions work with them so they will be ready to go.

Secretary – Charity mentioned dues is continuing to come in thanks to the efforts of Erica and the County Coordinators. She distributed the February meeting minutes via email. The members present felt they should be approved at the next meeting when more were in attendance.

Legislative Committee – Camila mentioned there are a few updates.

HB126 which extends the time for the notice of the execution of lien to the mortgagee from 45 days to 60 days was voted in committee as Ought to Pass (21-0).

HB260 was retained in committee. It was a tight vote 10-9. This bill is to allow certain vehicles to use one plate instead of two.

HB504 was retained in committee. This bill requires a significant amount of new language be included on the back of the tax bill. Camila is going to look into if we can submit a stance to the committee. Dawn feels the Association should oppose this bill.

Motion made by Dawn and seconded by Camila to oppose HB504 and present testimony to the committee, if allowed. All in favor. Motion carried.

Conference Coordinator – Terri let the committee know she will be following up with the hotel and will start putting things together for an in-person conference in October.

Education Committee – Dawn reported the committee is busy getting information together for the New Collectors’ workshop.

Dawn then reviewed what will be presented at the Spring workshops. The Saturday session will be on a Wednesday. There will be a session each Wednesday in April.

She also mentioned she is interested in hearing whatever topic ideas anyone has for the conference.

County Coordinator – Erica reported she is almost finished working on the spreadsheet breaking down the towns into counties for each of the Coordinators.

Director at Large – Hannah was wondering if longevity awards went out for 2020. Charity mentioned she thought we would wait and present both years at the in-person conference this fall.

Old Business – Terri mentioned that Kelly Roberts, 2nd VP stepped up to take over for Brenda Lapointe updating the website.

New Business – Nothing at this time.
